

Tile - 12" x 24"




Bono

This layout is offset by half of the length of the plank or tile. Can also be set to a 45° angle for alternate look.




Grid

Also referred to as a weave, this layout offers a variety of options in terms of mixing colors to create a truly unique environment.






Stacked

Planks set in no particular order for a more random, natural look.





Also known as a broken twill weave, is a V-shaped pattern resembling fish bone.




Corridor

Offset grid pattern of intervening rows.




Stagger

Alternating tiles or planks, offsetting the center line between them.




Wishbone




Mosaic

A grid-type pattern built using multiple planks to form a square.




Shifting bond

A bond variant combining two differently sized planks and tiles.

A double-plank pattern, offset in parallel lines.
