

# Altro floor cleaner

AltroClean 44+™

## Keep out of reach of children. Avoid contact with skin and eyes.

AltroClean 44+ is specially formulated to clean Altro safety flooring and in kitchens and other areas where removal of grease and cleanliness of floors is essential. It can also be used for removing old or worn coatings of seals / polishes from Altro smooth vinyl flooring.

#### Method of use

- 1. Sweep the floor.
- 2. Add AltroClean 44+ to clean, warm water; the dilution rate depends upon the degree of soiling (see below).
- Apply with suitable equipment such as a deck scrubber or similar, preferably a machine fitted with medium or heavy duty pads and leave for several minutes for the cleaner to attack the surface soil.
- 4. Rinse the floor with clean water and dry after use.

#### **Dilution rate**

Regular maintenance: use 1 part AltroClean 44+ to 140 parts clean, warm water. For heavily soiled floors: use 1 part AltroClean 44+ to 35 parts clean, warm water. This product can be used for the removal of emulsion based seals at a dilution rate of 1 part to 10 or 20 parts clean, warm water, depending on the emulsion based seal used.

#### General

### Health and safety precautions

Keep containers closed and away from children. This is an alkaline cleaner. As with all alkaline cleaners prolonged skin contact should be avoided. Wear rubber gloves.

#### First aid

**Skin:** The affected area should be irrigated with water and washed with soap.

**Eyes:** In case of contact with eyes irrigate with copious amounts of water. Seek medical attention.

**Ingestion**: Do not induce vomiting. Give drinks of milk or water and seek medical attention immediately.

## **Spillages**

Flush thoroughly with water. Available in 5 litres.
